



Disease status of Switzerland Attestation

The Federal Food Safety and Veterinary Office (FSVO) hereby confirms that:

- 1.) the **World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH)** has recognised Switzerland as officially "**free from**" the following diseases¹:

- African horse sickness
- Classical swine fever
- Contagious bovine pleuropneumonia
- Foot and mouth disease
- Peste des petits ruminants
- Rinderpest

- 2.) Switzerland is recognised by the **WOAH** as a country having a **negligible BSE risk**²;

- 3.) Switzerland is recognised by the **European Union** as **free from** the following diseases³:

- Aujeszky's disease
- Bovine brucellosis
- Bovine tuberculosis
- Caprine and ovine brucellosis
- Enzootic bovine leukosis
- Infectious bovine rhinotracheitis
- Infectious salmon anaemia
- Free from infection with Newcastle disease virus without vaccination
- Rabies

4.) Switzerland **declares itself officially free from** the following diseases⁴:

- African swine fever
- Avian influenza⁵
- Bovine genital campylobacteriosis
- Caprine arthritis/encephalitis
- Dourine
- Porcine brucellosis
- Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS)
- Rift valley fever
- Sheep pox and goat pox

5.) Switzerland declares that the following diseases **have never been detected**:

- Lumpy skin disease
