Part II: Zoosanitary information	<p>a) Consignments of milk or cream:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. the milk /cream has been handled, processed and packed under hygienic conditions and heat treated in accordance with the heat treatment regulations of Switzerland, it has not been adulterated with Melamine; ii. a report of chemical analysis showing the chemical composition of the milk is attached to this certificate; iii. a report of bacteriological examination showing the bacteriological quantity of the milk is attached to this certificate. <p>b) Consignments of frozen confection or ice cream:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. the frozen confection / ice cream was handled, processed and packed under hygienic conditions and had been heat treated in accordance with the frozen confection / ice cream heat treatment regulations of Switzerland; ii. the frozen confection / ice cream contains not more than 50,000 bacteria per gram or not more than 100 coliform organisms per gram of the frozen confection/ ice cream; iii. the frozen confection / ice cream contains not less than 5% fat, 10% sugar, 7.5% milk-solids-not-fat. (this condition applies to those frozen confection described as ice cream only); iv. a report of chemical analysis showing the chemical composition of the frozen confection / ice cream is attached to this certificate; v. a report of bacteriological examination showing the bacteriological quantity of the frozen confection / ice cream is attached to this certificate.
