Part II: Animal health attestation	<p>II.1 Animal Health Attestation</p> <p>The dairy products described above have been manufactured from raw milk obtained from animals,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – under the control of the official veterinary service, which were <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – in a country or region that has been free of foot-and-mouth disease and of rinderpest for at least 12 month, and where vaccination against foot-and-mouth disease has not been carried out for at least 12 month, – belonging to holdings which were not under restrictions due to foot-and-mouth disease or rinderpest, and – subject to a regular veterinary control with a view to the verification of compliance with the animal health conditions laid down in Council Directive 64/432/EEC. <p>The undersigned Official Veterinarian declares that he is familiar with the animal health requirements of Directive 64/432/EEC.</p> <p>II.2 Public Health Attestation</p> <p>The dairy products described above:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. were manufactured from raw milk: / heat-treated milk , which <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – does not, according to the findings of monitoring plans at least equivalent to those provided for in Directive 96/23/EEC, contain residues of anti-microbial substances in excess of the limits laid in Commission Regulation (EU) No 37/2010, as amended; – does not, according to the findings of monitoring plans at least equivalent to those provided for in Directive 96/23/EEC, contain pesticide residues in excess of the maximum levels laid down in Annex II and III to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005, as amended; – does not, according to the findings of monitoring plans at least equivalent to those provided for in Directive 96/23/EEC, contain contaminants in excess of the maximum tolerances laid down in the Community list provided for in Article 2 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 315/93 – does not, according to the findings of monitoring plans at least equivalent to those provided for in Directive 882/2004/EEC, contain residues of Melamin in excess of the limit of 1 mg/kg for liquid milk for infant or young children formula and 2,5 mg/kg for liquid milk (including raw milk), milk powder, and other formula milk powder or other food products that contain more than 15% milk. ; – comes from registered and checked holdings meeting the hygiene conditions laid down in Article 4 of the Ordinance 853/2004/EEC – was obtained, collected, cooled, stored and transported in accordance with the specific hygiene conditions laid down in Annex I of the ordinance 852/2004 EEC and Chapter IX, Annex III of the Ordinance 853/2004/EEC. – meets the plate and somatic cell counter standards laid down in Chapter IX, Annex III of the Ordinance 853/2004/EEC. – was collected and standardised, where necessary, in accordance with the hygiene conditions laid down in Chapter IV of Annex II of the ordinance 852/2004/EEC. / 2. come from treatment establishments and/or processing establishments offering equivalent guarantees to those laid down in the ordinance 853/2004/EEC shown on the list of establishments authorised to export and which is subject to supervision by the competent authority in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance 882/2004/EEC. ; 3. if heat-treated, have undergone heat treatment during manufacture in accordance with the specific requirements of Chapter XI of Annex II to Ordinance 853/2004/EEC; 4. meet the relevant microbiological criteria laid down in Ordinance 2073/2005/EEC 5. are examined according to national surveillance plans in approved laboratories and the results show that they are in conformity with national regulation for the levels of Dioxins and Dioxin-like PCBs. 6. have been wrapped and packaged in accordance with Annex III, Chapter IX of the ordinance 853/2004/EEC. 7. were stored and transported in accordance with the requirements of Annex II, Chapter IV of the ordinance 852/2004/EEC. 8. were transported, where appropriate, in tanks as described in Annex II, Chapter IV of the ordinance 852/2004/EEC. <p>The undersigned Certifying Officer declares that he is aware of the provisions contained in Directive 96/23/EEC/EEC, the ordinances 852/2004/EEC, 853/2004/EEC, 882/2004/EEC, 2073/2005/EEC, the Annex of Commission Regulation (EU) No 37/2010 and Regulation (EEC) 315/93.</p>
