HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I an authorised veterinarian of

the Government of Switzerland hereby certify that the milk / cheese / dairy products stipulated below:

1. were produced and processed in Switzerland only and originate from animals kept in areas which are not under any veterinary or quarantine restrictions;
2. were processed at a manufacturing plant approved by the veterinary services department and is under official veterinary supervision.
3. were subjected to at least one of the following processes:
 - i) pasteurised milk at not less than 60°C for 30 minutes or not less than 72°C for 15 seconds.
 - ii) sterilised milk at not less than 121 C for 30 minutes.
 - iii) UHT milk at no less than 132°C for not less than 3seconds.
 - iv) skimmed milk powder at not less than 120° C for 1 minute and spray dried at 200 C.
 - v) were acidified by bringing to pH of 4,7 or lower during manufacturing.
4. do not contain any harmful additives and are unconditionally passed fit for human consumption.
5. do not to the best of my belief and knowledge, constitute any risk of introducing infectious or contagious diseases into Zimbabwe.

Furthermore, I certify that:

- the milk or milk ingredient of which this product is made has been derived from a country and a herd officially free of Food an Mouth disease, Vesicular stomatitis, Swine vesicular disease, Rinderpest, Peste des petits ruminants, Contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, Lumpy skin disease, Rift Valley Fever, Sheep pox and goat pox, African horse sickness, African Swine Fever, Hog Cholera, Newcastele disease; officially free of Tuberculosis and officially free of brucellosis as regards bovine herds.
- the area within a radius of 10 kms from the place, where the manufacturer of the above mentioned product is situated, has been free of all the diseases mentioned above.
- no case of foot and mouth disease has occurred in Switzerland during the last 6 (six months).
- the agent causing Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE or also called Mad Cow disease) has never been detected in milk and there is not any scientific doubt about the absence of BSE in milk and therefore the mentioned product(s) is/are regarded as free of BSE and in this respect completely safe for human consumption
