Exportation de viande de porc à Hong Kong: Conditions pour les exportateurs et importateurs

En plus du certificat sanitaire, les autorités compétentes de Hong Kong ont fait parvenir les conditions obligatoires suivantes pour l'exportation de viande de porc et produits à base de viande de porc vers Hong Kong :

This Department has no objection in principle to the importation of frozen / chilled pork from Switzerland into the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) on a new trial shipment basis subject to compliance with the following conditions:

- a. Prior written permission shall be obtained by Hong Kong importers in advance from this Department for every shipment;
- b. Each consignment shall be accompanied by an agreed format of health certificate issued by the Swiss Cantonal Veterinary Services;
- c. Only meat processed by the slaughtering and processing plants approved for export by the Swiss health authority can be exported to the HKSAR
- d. The consignment shall be conveyed under proper refrigeration;
- e. If the consignment transships through a country other than the country of origin, additional condition may be stipulated;
- f. On arrival, the consignment shall be subject to inspection by health inspectors of this Department prior to release;
- g. An import licence shall be obtained from the Food Importer / Distributor Registration and Import Licensing Office of this Department and submitted for verification; and
- h. A list showing all names and addresses of the distributors and retailers to whom the pork is supplied plus the quantity of meat supplied to each individual distributor or retailer shall be provided to this Department upon arrival at the HKSAR.
