<b>Part II: Zoosanitary information</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The meat was derived from domestic animals of Swiss origin and the animals had been in Switzerland for a period at least three months prior to the date of slaughter.</li> <li>2. Switzerland was free from Foot and Mouth Disease, Rinderpest, Swine Fever and Trichinosis (in domestic pigs for at least 6 months prior the date of export.</li> <li>3. The meat and meat products herein described were derived from domestic animals, which had been subjected to ante and post mortem examination and have been found to be free from infectious and contagious diseases.</li> <li>4. The meat and meat products herein described are fit for human consumption and every precaution had been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.</li> <li>5. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) The pigs were slaughtered, processed, cut and stored in an approved plant by the Swiss health authority for export purpose;</li> <li>b) The pigs have been slaughtered, processed, prepared and dressed hygienically under the conditions and control laid down in the relevant Swiss legislation and directives in force;</li> <li>c) The meat and meat products herein described were packed and transported under hygienic conditions;</li> <li>d) The meat and meat products herein described have been subject to the testing programs for harmful organisms, veterinary drug residues and other toxic substances administered by the Swiss health authority. The results of the tests have not provided any evidence as to the presence of chemical/drug residues or toxic substances, which could be harmful to human health.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
