**Part V: Notes for completion - LIVE ANIMALS**

These notes for completion must be read and understood by the certifying officer before signing the certificate. Notes are set out in sections that correspond to the sections in the certificate. By signing this certificate, certifiers are verifying that the consignment meets the requirements set out in the certificate and any relevant corresponding notes for completion.

These notes do not need to be printed as part of a paper certificate that accompanies the consignment or in any electronic copy of the certificate.

References to European Union legislation within this certificate are references to direct EU legislation which has been retained in Great Britain (retained EU law as defined in the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018) and can be viewed on the UK legislation website (legislation.gov.uk).

References to Great Britain in this certificate include Channel Islands and Isle of Man.

References to GB requirements refer to the requirement(s) of Great Britain as set out in the accompanying notes for completion.

**Part I**

- Box reference I.15: Registration number (railway wagons or container and lorries), flight number (aircraft) or name (ship) is to be provided. In case of unloading and reloading, the consignor must inform the BCP of entry into GB.
- Box reference I.28: Identification system: Specify the identification system (tag, tattoos, brand, chip, transponder, crate or container number). Large quantities of small animals, the crates or container must be identified in such a way that the original or transit holding or the last holding of residence or the centre or organization prior to export can be traced back to the country of origin.
- Box reference I.28: Age: months; Sex (M = male, F = female, C = castrated);

**AH/T509 Territory requirements**

No further notes for completion.

**AH/E505 Establishment requirements**

The premises of origin must:

- be registered by the competent authority of the country or territory described in box I.7;
  - not be subjected to any restrictions relating to a national programme for the control of infectious diseases, which the animals on this certificate are susceptible to;
  - have had no clinical cases of rabies for the last 6 months.
- and
- the animals must have remained in this premises since birth or for the last 30 days before dispatch to GB,

**AH/A108 Animal requirements**

Vaccination is not compulsory, but if the animals have been vaccinated, information on the vaccine(s) used and the time of vaccination must be filled in.

**AH/A352 Animal requirements (transport)**

“GB requirements” refer to means of transport which were cleaned and disinfected before loading with an officially authorised disinfectant and so constructed that faeces, urine, litter or fodder could not flow or fall out of the vehicle or container during transportation.

**Date of loading**

Imports of these animals shall not be allowed when the animals were loaded either prior to the date of authorisation for exportation to Great Britain of the third country, territory or part thereof referred to in boxes reference I.7 and I.8, or during a period where restrictive measures have been adopted by Great Britain against imports of these animals from this third country, territory or part thereof.

**AH/A614A Animal requirements (parasite treatment)**

Parasite treatment is not compulsory, but if the animals have been treated, information on the product(s) used and the active ingredients must be filled in.

**AH/A615 Animal requirements**

No further notes for completion.

**AH/A624 Animal requirement**

GB requirements:

Animals:

- have not come into contact with other animals not complying with at least the same health requirements as described in this certificate for the last 30 days and during their transportation from the premises of origin to the place of shipment;
- were examined by an official veterinarian within 48 hours of loading and showed no clinical sign of disease and are fit for the intended transport;
- are not animals to be killed under a national programme for the eradication of diseases.
- (for lagomorph only) have come from a holding in which no animal showed clinical signs of myxomatosis.
