<b>Part II: Sanitary information</b>	<p><b>II.1 Animal health attestation</b></p> <p>I, the undersigned certifying Officer, declare that I am aware of the relevant provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 and of Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 and hereby certify that the dairy product described above:</p> <p>(a) has been obtained from animals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) under the control of the official veterinary service,</li> <li>(ii) which were in a country or part thereof that has been free of foot-and-mouth disease and of rinderpest for a period of at least 12 months prior to the date of this certificate, and where vaccination against foot-and-mouth disease has not been carried out during that period,</li> <li>(iii) belonging to holdings which were not under restrictions due to foot-and-mouth disease or rinderpest and,</li> <li>(iv) subject to regular veterinary inspections to ensure that they satisfy the animal health conditions laid down in Chapter I of Section IX of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 and in Regulation (EU) 2016/429,</li> </ul> <p><b>II.2. Public Health attestation</b></p> <p>I, the undersigned certifying Officer, declare that I am aware of the relevant provisions of Regulations (EC) No 178/2002, (EC) No 852/2004, (EC) No 853/2004 and (EC) No 2017/625 and hereby certify that the dairy product described above was produced in accordance with those provisions, in particular that:</p> <p>(a) It was manufactured from raw milk:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) which comes from holdings registered in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 and checked in accordance with Article 18 to Regulation (EC) No 2017/625,</li> <li>(ii) which was produced, collected, cooled, stored and transported in accordance with the hygiene conditions laid down in Chapter I of Section IX of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004,</li> <li>(iii) which meets the plate and somatic cell count criteria laid down in Chapter I of Section IX of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004,</li> <li>(iv) which does not contain antibiotic residues exceeding the limits authorized under the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 37/2010,</li> <li>(v) which does not contain pesticide residues exceeding the limits authorized by Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 and</li> <li>(vi) which does not contain contaminants exceeding the maximum tolerances laid down by Regulation (EC) No 1881/2006,</li> </ul> <p>(b) It has undergone or been produced from raw milk which :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> has been submitted to a pasteurisation treatment involving a single heat treatment with a heating effect at least equivalent to that achieved by a pasteurisation process of at least 72°C for 15 seconds and where applicable, sufficient to ensure a negative reaction to an alkaline phosphatase test applied immediately after the heat treatment,</li> <li>or,</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> has not been submitted to a pasteurisation treatment but to a maturation for at least 60 days at a temperature of at least 2 °C prior to the exportation to Israel.</li> </ul> <p>(c) it comes from an establishment implementing a programme based on the HACCP principles in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004,</p> <p>(d) it has been processed, stored, wrapped, packaged and transported in accordance with the relevant hygiene conditions laid down in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 and Chapter II of Section IX of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004,</p> <p>(e) it meets the relevant criteria laid down in Chapter II of Section IX of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 and the relevant microbiological criteria laid down in Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005 on microbiological criteria for foodstuffs,</p> <p>(f) the guarantees covering live animals and products thereof provided by the residue plans submitted in accordance with Regulation (EC) 2017/625, and in particular Articles 47 to 64, 113, 125, 127 and 129 thereof, are fulfilled.</p>
